The doe/buck KID From
And

Here is their agreement:

1. Price is \$_____. Discount \$25 on 2nd kid.
2. The Buyer will make a deposit of \$100 and pay the remainder when the kid is on the ground. The deposit is refundable anytime the Buyer changes their mind.
3. The Buyer will pay all shipping costs, including any crates.
4. Shipping promptly at 4 weeks of age. If the buyer delays the shipping past that date then the buyer has to pick up the additional cost of raising the kid at \$1.75 per day per kid.
5. The Seller MUST SELL no matter how good the kid is.
6. The Buyers DO have the right to TURN DOWN a kid
7. The Seller has done the following to insure the kids do not contract CAE:
 - A. Tape dam's teats NO LATER THAN 8 days before her due date.
 - B. Refrain from feeding goat colostrum, heated or not. Feed cow colostrum instead.
 - C. Feed pasteurized milk ONLY at EVERY FEEDING.
8. This contract is for the FIRST kid from each dam. In case there is more than one, "First" is not as normally defined, *i.e.*, showiest. "First" is defined as:
 - A. The most dominant. Dominant is defined as biggest, pushiest, most vigorous, most active. Where one kid is seen lying around while the other kid is up and moving, the one up is the dominant one. In case of tie, one

lambar nipple is offered and whoever pushes the other kid off is dominant. In case of tie, the ounces of milk consumed at each feeding will be recorded and whoever consumes the most will be "dominant."

- B. The greatest width between the hocks.
- C. The straightest, shortest rear pasterns.
- D. No other conformational items are to count.
- E. "First" can be defined anyway the Buyer wants.

9. Any disputes to be resolved under the laws of the state of the Buyer.

10. This contract is void if another deposit is received before the Buyer's.

11. This contract is only for the next year's kidding. In future years the Seller may change the price.

12. If there are two kids born the Buyer gets the best one.

13. Each kid must be sired by the specified buck, not some other buck.

14. The Buyer can return the kid for a complete refund of the purchase price anytime up to two years of age. In the case of a buck, minus \$40.00 for each registered descendent. In the case of either a buck or a doe, minus one-half without a Negative CAE Test.

15. The Seller pays for the American Dairy Goat Assn. registration papers and the collar. These two items are included in the price. The Seller pays for normal DOMESTIC shipping vet costs. The Buyer(s) pays any abnormal vet costs ("abnormal" includes extra vet fees for export). The Buyer pays for the transfer (\$3.50) if they decide to register the kids(s) in their name.

15. If the Buyer reserves more than five kids and cancels, their deposits will be refunded immediately in full. But tie up over five and cancel, then on the sixth and following kids \$1.20 per day boarding for three weeks will be charged.
