## Terms and Conditions

### Refund Policy

The buyers DO have the right to TURN DOWN a kid.

**Before Birth** The buyer will make a deposit of 100, and pay the remainder when the kid is on the ground. The deposit and the purchase price is refundable anytime the buyer changes their mind.

**After** The buyer can return the kid for a complete refund of the purchase price anytime up to eighteen months of age. In the case of a buck, minus 40 for each registered descendent. In the case of either a buck or doe, minus half the price without a Negative CAE test.

**Large Purchases** If the buyer reserves more than five kids and cancels, their deposits will be refunded immediately in full. But if you tie up more than five kids, and cancel, then on the sixth and following kids \$4.50 per day boarding for three weeks will be charged.

### Selection of Your Kid

Each kid must be sired by the specified buck, not some other buck.

The sellers **must sell** no matter how good the kid is.

If there are two kids born, the buyer gets the best one.

Your order is for the FIRST kid from each dam. In case there are more than one, "First" means the one you like best. If you leave it up to us, then: first is not necessarily the showiest.

We define "first" as:

- A. The most dominant. Dominant is defined as biggest pushiest most vigorous most active. Where one kid is seen lying around while the other kid is up and moving the one up is the dominant one. In case of tie, whoever consumes the most milk is "dominant".
- B. The greatest width between the hocks.
- C. The straightest shortest rear pasterns.
- D. No other conformational items are to count.

When boarding after four weeks uses up the deposit, the kid is no longer reserved.

Any disputes to be resolved under the laws of the state of Maryland.

This contract is void if another deposit is received before the buyers.

**Shipping** should happen at 28 days. After 28 days we begin to charge boarding. If the boarding uses up your deposit(s) then it is no longer reserved to you, and others may buy it. The buyer will pay all shipping costs including any crates. If shipping is delayed due to buyer, the buyer will pay \$4.50 per day per kid to raise the kid for each day after the set apart 4 weeks until weaning. Then \$3.75/day. \$.75 /mile round trip delivery.

This price is for this year's kid - the next kid. No matter how well the dam does before she kids. But after she kids, the next kids are priced different. **BE SURE YOU ARE USING THE MOST RECENT PRICE LIST!**

If you are, your price for the next kidding is fixed!

### Registration and Fees

The seller pays for the American Dairy Goat Assn registration papers and the collar. Domestic shipping papers are \$75 if the buyer wants them. The buyer(s) pays any abnormal vet costs ("abnormal" includes extra vet fees or quarantine for export). If your kid flunks any of the extra tests your country requires, you have lost those fees. For export there is a flat charge of \$295 for paperwork satisfying the 6 veterinarians involved in export plus the USDA fee plus the local vet fee and lab tests. Canada is 95 extra. The buyer pays for the transfer (\$3.50) if they decide to register the kid(s) in their name.
