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**A dairy farmer wrote in with the question:**

“Is it really worth paying more for the more expensive buck?”

**Scott wrote back, in Spring 2016:**

“The answer is I don’t know.

Here is one dollar and cents approach I thought of.

There are 16 **99th** %ile does. The average PTAM of those 16 is 333.

There are 16 **95th** %ile does. the average PTAM of those 16 is 230.

So it looks like for every one percentile drop the milk goes down by 26 pounds. HENOOSKI had a dam with a PTAM of a 93 so that would be 7 percentiles down from HAN SHOT FIRST.

26 pounds times 6 percentiles = 156 lb /year. So that would mean on average his daughters will give you 156 less pounds every year, year after year. And his granddaughters will give you one - half of 156 pounds year after year. So if you are milking 80, then  $80 \times 26 \times 7 \times .41/\text{pound} = \$5,970$

80 does times 156 pounds equals 12,480 pounds per year.

12,480 pounds per year @ \$40cwt = \$4,992.

5 years of milk from each doe equals \$24,960.

That’s my guess.”

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A lot of work needs to be done to make this computation more accurate.

First, what about the granddaughters and great granddaughters?  
Nothing was added to the \$24,960 for them.

Second, probably starting by comparing the 99<sup>th</sup> percentile to the 95<sup>th</sup> percentile is not right. Because the 99<sup>th</sup> percentile will have a few that are REALLY crazy for milk.

So, if we found 16 does in 85<sup>th</sup> percentile and averaged their milk (PTAM). Then subtracted that number from 230, which is the average for the 16 in the 95<sup>th</sup> percentile. That would give us the drop for ten percentiles. Dividing that by 10 would probably give us a more accurate figure than 26 pounds per percentile.

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Update August 14, 2017

The **95<sup>th</sup>** percentile does average **243** per PTAM.

The **98<sup>th</sup>** percentile does average **302** per PTAM.

Increase of **59** pounds per year.

There are **3** percentage points between **95 & 98**.

Therefore each percentile translates into **20** pounds of milk per doe per year.

So, for example. If I have a normal non tested herd, that might be **40<sup>th</sup>** percentile.

If you use **90<sup>th</sup>** percentile bucks long enough, you move up by **1,000** pounds per doe per year.

The **99<sup>th</sup>** percentile moves you up much more than **20lb**.

On 6/15/16, Scott said HIGH BAIL looks great but has loose shoulders. On 7/25/16 four Amish Dairymen were here and HIGH BAIL was in consideration. But he was not one of the three they picked. What Scott saw was “A lot of dairy character, very good escutcheon, good-looking, maybe a little top line weakness if you are looking for it.” There may be other BAR EXAM buck kids some day. But none sired by ECLIPSE, who died.

On Aug 22 2017 we needed a young guy to go in with the 4 does in the 1-2-3 Pen. All four of the young guys we want to prove: HERC, MEADOW HAWK, HONDURAS, and HOT ROCKS were too closely related to one or more of those does so we picked HIGH BAIL.

Scott says “Tad bit narrow from the back. Little topline dip. Sharp withers, Steep rump, Very good in the front. Almost tight toes. Very good shoulders.”

At that time there were only 16 living Saanen 99<sup>th</sup> percentile does. 99 is as high as USDA goes. ILEX beat the whole herd in milk/fat/protein. 3.2% is as high as Saanen's go in protein. An upstanding doe with no attachments.

She is a tribute to Cecile Beauchemin, who had the will power to stay on DHI test for years, and to always breed to Sire Summary/Top buck List/ Elite/ Top 15% bucks. Never bothered to show.

We said: "She is dying as of April 2016."

When CRUZERIO did 5100, totally smashing our previous record, everything became lined on her. Then we lost the Big Arc. SPRING’s descendants will bring it back. As of November 2012, Violets lifetime was 1,396 days 15,575 milk. She had cream, not white hair and an undesirable Saanen nose. It’s so easy to be the top Saanen milk herd. The other breeders select for color and noses. We can just keep selecting for milk/fat/protein, all wrapped into one number called “percentile,” or “Rank”. VIOLET “HAD IT ALL” the GCH and the 92 and the components

It is very unusual for there to be two straight generations of 92's. There are very few Saanen 92's in any given year.

That said the SGCH’s and the Top Tens make HAWK a Spotlight Sale buck. But the sale is in Texas, not dairy country, this year. HAWK is longer than the other buck kids like his dam and her brother, MEADOW BOSS, one of our main herd sires.

This one hurt! MEADOW HAWK had a full brother, MEADOW HAWK 2. He got what we call “the Bulldog” - front shoulders loose, front legs crooked-bowing out, winging out. SALE BARN. A \$5,000 hurt.

All four of the young guys we want to prove: HERC, MEADOW HAWK, HONDURAS, and HOT ROCKS were too closely related to one or more of those does so we picked HIGH BAIL. Now we will have testing fees and appraisals invested in him so he became \$1,795. But basically these two bucks are identical.

BING was bought, but he begat NEW ERA #424, before he left. So now we have the start of a new breed of Saanens that kid at a younger age so the dairy farmer doesnt keep losing money on them while they are dry.

Our oldest doe as of February 2016 and TESTED PREGNANT! We use her son, NEW ERA, #424. And HERACLES will probably be our clen up buck this winter.

11.7 pounds here minus 9 pounds there equals 2.7 lb per day times 150 does times 300 days times \$42/hundredweight equals \$51,030 more per year.

HERACLES does have a weakness - his dam's b.f.%. ECLIPSE should bring that up, but not enough for it to be positive.

HERACLES has one rear foot that Scott calls a "rocker foot."

This is an awesome choice for a herd that is commercial and has some mixture of Alpines and Saanens because Scott used this buck heavily as the clean-up buck at Caprikorn Farms. So you know that he's got the milk. Starting in 2017 we became dismayed with the back pasterns. Other herds will take a beautiful udder and a poor set of back pasterns. At Caprikorn we would rather have strong back pasterns and a not so pretty udder. If you have a mixed herd, then you probably have good back pasterns. We are Saanen breeders and we have always bred for strong back pasterns because all 120 Saanens that were brought into the U.S. had poor back pasterns.

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
