A dairy farmer wrote in with the question:

“Is it really worth paying more for the more expensive buck?”

Scott wrote back, in Spring 2016:

“The answer is I don’t know.

Here is one dollar and cents approach I thought of.

There are 16 **99th** %ile does. The average PTAM of those 16 is 333.

There are 16 **95th** %ile does. the average PTAM of those 16 is 230.

So it looks like for every one percentile drop the milk goes down by 26 pounds. HENOOSKI had a dam with a PTAM of a 93 so that would be 7 percentiles down from HAN SHOT FIRST.

26 pounds times 6 percentiles = 156 lb /year. So that would mean on average his daughters will give you 156 less pounds every year, year after year. And his granddaughters will give you one - half of 156 pounds year after year. So if you are milking 80, then $80 \times 26 \times 7 \times .41/\text{pound} = \$5,970$

80 does times 156 pounds equals 12,480 pounds per year.

12,480 pounds per year @ \$40cwt = \$4,992.

5 years of milk from each doe equals \$24,960.

That’s my guess.”

A lot of work needs to be done to make this computation more accurate.

First, what about the granddaughters and great granddaughters?
Nothing was added to the \$24,960 for them.

Second, probably starting by comparing the 99th percentile to the 95th percentile is not right. Because the 99th percentile will have a few that are REALLY crazy for milk.

So, if we found 16 does in 85th percentile and averaged their milk (PTAM). Then subtracted that number from 230, which is the average for the 16 in the 95th percentile. That would give us the drop for ten percentiles. Dividing that by 10 would probably give us a more accurate figure than 26 pounds per percentile.

Update August 14, 2017

The **95th** percentile does average **243** per PTAM.

The **98th** percentile does average **302** per PTAM.

Increase of **59** pounds per year.

There are **3** percentage points between **95 & 98**.

Therefore each percentile translates into **20** pounds of milk per doe per year.

So, for example. If I have a normal non tested herd, that might be **40th** percentile.

If you use **90th** percentile bucks long enough, you move up by **1,000** pounds per doe per year.

The **99th** percentile moves you up much more than **20lb**.

We had a disastrous test on Oct. 20, 2009, but XTORT held her milk. Maybe she likes to eat soggy round bales out in the rain. Her sister lives in Canada now.

Perfect buck kid for dairyman that does not register. A long history behind this doe. We got an employment application from a person working in the Likuni Boys School in Africa. He became our herd manager and later started his own unregistered herd with our stock. When one of his does, PEPPER, went 5,000 on DHI, we got her dau. That was VANILLA, who completely lost one rear foot but kept on trucking with a **wide** mammary..

XTORT is for people who love goats who love people. She was the only kid to break out of the kid prison to follow you around while you do chores.

As of April 2017 she was first in the herd in lifetime milk, fat and protein.

Her lifetime fat was OVER 1,000 LB.. The closest doe to her only had 700.!!

Milk OVER 31,000 lb. Some cows don't get that far.

XTORT's mammary milks way down. This means she should get an “e” for udder texture. But the Appraiser wouldn't give her one. The Linear Appraisal program is great but it DOES HAVE a box for udder texture and it DOES NOT have a box for TOPLINE or SHARP WITHERS.

XTORT is not a big doe, making her milk records even more remarkable.

XTORT'S DAU CUMIN IS BEATING THE ENTIRE HERD as of August 2014, even though she

is only 2 y o. She made Top Ten. And CUMIN again beat the whole herd in 2015. And so far in May of 2016.

PREGNANT - THANK YOU GOD! - FEBRUARY 2016 - NINE YEARS OLD! But aborted.

Not pregnant Dec 2016. She can stay here though.

Yes Pregnant February 2017 10 years Old. Pray she can carry. She did. #787 JUNIPER and #788 JUNIPUR

For example ELKO is Milk Plus 100, Fat plus .07, Protein plus .06

And ELKO is 89th. So BOSS is around 93.

But the computer won't list him there until there is a tested dau in a SECOND herd.

We took BOSS to his first show on June 8th of 2014. He was 3rd of 3 in Rings 1 & 2. He was second of three in Rings 3 & 4. In Ring 4, the buck that beat him went on to be the Grand Champion.

He is longer and taller than other Saanen bucks with very sharp withers. He looks awesome from the side and he is too narrow viewed from the rear. In 2012 Ben Rupchis placed him first over the other "B" bucks (BULGING EYE, STARBY, BIZNES) in spite of the narrow rear end.

Aborted December 2014.

After Nationals, she beat everyone including the Cherry Glen Nat'l Show doe at Frederick in September 2014. Wayne Cullen said oe word: "Rump."

Freshened in very late in 2015, June 28, with radically uneven halves. Alice says that was caused by prefreshening mastitis. As of September 1, they are starting to be much more even., but still unshowable.

Freshened in 2016. Still uneven. This doe was a mystery. Need more tests. April 2016 test right in the middle of the 2 year olds, but bag is not even close to being full.

Friendly.

She's really big. She's capable of cruising to well over 5,000 in 305 WITHOUT BAGGING.

She kidded in March 2016 and the mammary was uneven again. URRGHHH! Same for 2017 when she came with three dead kids. She is a big power doe, and a lover, but too sensitive. Needed to be stretchier.

KELLIX is priced that low because FELIXA, in spite of her very good lactations so far, is only rated at 91st % ile by the USDA computer program. 91st means she is better genetically than 10 out of 11 **TESTED Saanen does**. On th average KEELIX’s sire, CZARBUCK will kick that number up.

The other breeders select for color and noses. We can just keep selecting for milk/fat/protein, all wrapped into one number called "percentile," or "Rank". VIOLET "HAD IT ALL"

It is very unusual for their to be two straight generations of 92's. There are very few Saanen 92's in any given year.
