**A dairy farmer wrote in with the question:**

“Is it really worth paying more for the more expensive buck?”

**Scott wrote back, in Spring 2016:**

“The answer is I don’t know.

Here is one dollar and cents approach I thought of.

There are 16 **99th** %ile does. The average PTAM of those 16 is 333.

There are 16 **95th** %ile does. The average PTAM of those 16 is 230.

So it looks like for every one percentile drop the milk goes down by 26 pounds. HENOOSKI had a dam with a PTAM of a 93 so that would be 7 percentiles down from HAN SHOT FIRST.

26 pounds times 6 percentiles = 156 lb /year. So that would mean on average his daughters will give you 156 less pounds every year, year after year. And his granddaughters will give you one - half of 156 pounds year after year. So if you are milking 80, then  $80 \times 26 \times 7 \times .41/\text{pound} = \$5,970$

80 does x 156 pounds = 12,480 pounds per year.

12,480 pounds per year @ \$40cwt = \$4,992.

5 years of milk from each doe equals \$24,960.

That’s my guess.”

\*\*\*\*\*

A lot of work needs to be done to make this computation more accurate.

First, what about the granddaughters and great granddaughters?

Nothing was added to the \$24,960 for them.

Second, probably starting by comparing the 99<sup>th</sup> percentile to the 95<sup>th</sup> percentile is not right. Because the 99<sup>th</sup> percentile will have a few that are REALLY crazy for milk.

So, if we found 16 does in 85<sup>th</sup> percentile and averaged their milk (PTAM). Then subtracted that number from 230, which is the average for the 16 in the 95<sup>th</sup> percentile. That would give us the drop for 10 percentiles. Dividing that by 10 would probably give us a more accurate figure than 26 pounds per percentile.

The 95<sup>th</sup> percentile does average **243** per PTAM.

The 98<sup>th</sup> percentile does average **302** per PTAM.

Increase of 59 pounds per year.

There are 3 percentage points between 95 & 98.

Therefore each percentile translates into **20** pounds of milk per doe per year.

So, for example, if you have a normal non-tested herd, that MIGHT be 40<sup>th</sup> percentile.

If you use 90<sup>th</sup> percentile bucks, you move up by 1,000 pounds per doe per year.  
(20 pounds times 50 percentiles)

If you are getting \$53 cwt, your income goes up by \$39,000 for every 100 does you milk.

One had 397 and the other plus 457 PTAM. 457 is better than any buck on the Elite buck list. ELSON had 36 registered dau's as of October 2013. The Appraisers waved YELSON off. They have to do ALL the does. But they try to save us the embarrassment of a low score on bucks. So they say “You don't want to do him” when he starts coming out of the pen. But we loved his Rear End Assembly. The Big Arc.

An ELITE DOE (which strictly measures milk/fat/protein genes). VIOLET had "INVERSION" - more protein than fat. We chose VIOLET's twin VERN to breed the awesome does STARGATE and VENICE Nine pounds at birth. We had named VIOLET'S dam to honor Tina Gilchrist's immortal GCH FOOTHILL FARM MEADOW SPRING TOP TEN LA 90. Dam had the big arc 35. And Rear Udder height: 38. Dam had extra teat. VIOLET started life with the RENOV steep rump. That changed. Her picture is on the website in front of the NYMPHIE (MEADOW ) Family.

We don't want to waste time on conformation but one item we do want is "The Big Arc"! We used to have big wide escutcheons. As of November 2012, Violets lifetime was 1,396 days 15,575 milk. She had cream, not white hair and an undesirable Saanen nose. It's so easy to be the top Saanen milk herd. The other breeders select for color and noses. We can just keep selecting for milk/fat/protein, all wrapped into one number called "percentile," or "Rank". VIOLET "HAD IT ALL"

It is very unusual for there to be two straight generations of 92's. There are very few Saanen 92's in any given year.

On August 1, 2018 Scott said, "This is a beautiful vigorous buck with a lovely top line and big width up front. His negative is that his rear end assembly is too narrow and he is too hocky. A lot of the look of his close relative MEADOW BOSS is here. But the family keeps coming with 92's so it appears that the rear end narrow doesn't get passed on to female offspring. Will be looking hard at his first few daughters as they freshen to see if this trait is showing up."

On June 14, 2020 a very good ADGA judge placed 18 SENIOR bucks ( no kids) at CAPRIKORN and she made HAWK Reserve Grand Champion.
