NELLIE was our favorite when we spotted her from out of the blue at the MDGA Doe Show around 1991. Then the next year we watched her two dau's INDY and JUSTICE switch places at the top of their classes.

JUSTICE'S full-sister-same-get INDEPENDENCE appraised 92 and milked 02-00 300 3650 102 2.8 101 2.8, and finished FIRST AT THE '97 NATIONALS. NELLIE was Maryland's dominant show doe.

Thanks again to Susie Knapp (and Ma Brown and Kathy Iager and Brad & Terri Wigle)we are able to continue our program of linebreeding on NELLIE with the addition of JUSTICE. CHALLENGER was a Sire Summary buck.

JUSTICE was never shown as a milker because she only has 1/2 of an udder. JUSTICE had markings similar to a HOLSTEIN. She had a fabulous looking mammary, at least the remaining half, and an excellent rear end assembly, big arc and short thick straight rear pasterns. Usually those strong bones mean less milk but not this time.

JUSTICE'S dau FREEDOM was #1 on 2003 Top Five for Alpine Grades, with 305 4440.

EVERY Justice dau turned out good!

SAUSIE LET Scott hold "INDY" briefly in the ring at Nationals and he will tell you she was WAY BETTER BUILT than anything in that class.

Due to an udder injury, JUSTICE herself was hardly ever milked.

BUYERS TIP: Early January babies have an advantage over the other kids. And they **still** have an advantage when they are yearlings and even two YEAR OLDS!

buyer's tip: the corollary to the buyer's tip on the preceding page is that you can get a good deal on late kids. The Appraisers and Judges are just thinking "Milking Yearling." They don't move the late kids up. In fact a January baby being shown the following May should be a full one-third bigger than a May baby. (Four months older divided by 12 months - the age of the May baby. **These are often the yearlings that the owner has ranked low on his or her "Keeper List."**

And in one ring the judge made him **Reserve Grand Champion** versus eleven Saanen bucks”. At 5 her pasterns are starting to weaken. Urrgh, But we have so many 90's that can do 4,000 also we will sell her sons cheap.

We used her son HIGH BAIL until he was bought.

Whiteside ZEPP0 has 46 registered dau’s as of January 2016. His dau’s are BIGGER, AND THAT IS
IMPORTANT TO US. Because a 16 lb milker that is small is more likely to give a dairy farmer health
problems. But a 16 Lb. Milker that is BIG can handle it. ZEPP0 is Mr. Protein. He has the second highest
protein % of any of our bucks, ever. To breed for higher fat and protein you have to sacrifice a little milk.
BUT BE AWARE THE HIGHER FAT/PROTEIN DOE BRINGS IN A BIGGER MILK CHECK. The
winners of the Four Milk and Fat Awards at the 2016 Nationals were both ZEPP0 dau’s.

On April 30, Scott said: “It is unlikely that HIGHFLYER can have the monster CAPRIKORN
milk/fat/protein that we stand for. This is because TIBERIUS’S dam, the national champion, had no
milk, and, therefore, TIBERIUS will always be hovering around the 50th percentile.

So any time you see TIBERIUS, you know we made a show breeding. FIRE BOLT, HIGH
FLYER’S dam, was the showiest of the triplets from AIRACOBRA and BOSS.

Scott looked at the doe on April 30 when she was fresh for a few weeks and he had this to say:

“There is a ridge on the rump and that will never change. The rump angle is good or very good, but
not excellent. That is going to improve with age. The doe will probably get a 90 when she is 4 years
old. The withers are a little higher than the rump. The feet and the legs are good. There is good
extension to the fore udder. A minus is that the rear udder could be higher. Maybe it will be when
we bag her up, so, considering the milk, we are going to have to hope that she does really well in the
shows to stay here.”

At CAPRIKORN, we usually buy by pre-ordering unborn kids. Gives us a “live lottery ticket”.

ONCE YOU SEND IN YOUR UNBORN KID ORDER FORM YOUR PRICE DOESN'T CHANGE.

AND YOU CAN CHANGE YOUR MIND ANYTIME.

Our DHI number is 51-17-5343, you can go to cdcb.us or adgagenetics.org and get the up to date real DHI records anytime,

Our cow testers name is Terry Martin and his number is (717)-725-2500. You can call him and verify that our

records are real. We have always been on Standard officials Test, not any of the flaky cheap plans where you

can record your own number. Owner Sampler- what a joke!

It is weird enough to be a goat dairyman. To then go and allow a weird testing plan.....

12 pounds x 300 days equals 3600. So, if we had dealt with her milk fever in the beginning of her lactation, when the production is way higher than the 12 pounds, what a monster lactation she would have turned in. She got milk fever, and it killed her. Alice was in the hospital having an operation of her own and we failed to treat RESTITUTION properly. It also killed her two year old lactation.

DD: JUSTICE!

Dairymen bought her buck kids even though they were unregistered.

SINCERITY was a doe you could depend on to deliver excellent milk and babies.

She had the most lifetime milk of any doe in the herd. First test at 6 y.o. 17.5lbs.

Her first doe lives in Missouri and her second doe lives in Texas. One buck is a herd sire in NC (dairy).
