Plenty of milk but low components mostly. In these last few years it has become a Show Family, the kind of does that are the choice of the NSBA type people. These are the breeders that tell you: "we breed for milk and show." That usually means "We always end up using the showiest buck available but we like to talk about milk. Especially if one of our show does accidentally comes up with a big lactation." In our 40 years in the biz, we have never seen an NSBA'er breed for or even mention COMPONENTS.
