These are the breeders that tell you: "we breed for milk and show." That usually means "We always end up using the showiest buck available but we like to talk about milk. Especially if one of our show does accidentally comes up with a big lactation." In our 40 years in the biz, we have never seen an NSBA'er breed for or even mention COMPONENTS.

with the RENOV steep rump. That changed. We don't want to waste time on conformation but one item we do want is "The Big Arc"! We used to have big wide escutcheons. When

CRUZERIO did 5100, totally smashing our previous record, everything became lined on her. Then we lost the Big Arc. SPRING's descendants will bring it back. She had cream, not white

hair and an undesirable Saanen nose. It's so easy to be the top Saanen **milk** herd. The other breeders select for color and noses. We just keep selecting for milk/fat/protein, She "HAD IT

ALL." Her son MEADOW BOSS is on the Aug. 2017 Elite Buck List

His sister went for 2,600 and his brother went for 2,395 So Alice jacked up the price because she would like to have a ROCKET son for a change. All the others were bought This was an awesome looking baby buck. He had that sweeping look judge's love, starting from high sharp withers, traveling back along straight topline to a very good rump angle, being lower in the rump than the withers. Then he became a yearling. Our yearling bucks are ugly. One place Scott can fault him is the rump could be wider. Secondly, ZURICH has a slight minus for PTAFS.

Cobalt is plus for type.

His PTAM, PTAF and PTAP% would make him about the equivalent of 95%ile. But although he has 24 registered dau's none have ever been on a test in a DIFFERENT herd than CAPRIKORN. So he does not print on the Top Buck (cdcd.us) or Elite Buck lists. IT IS RARE FOR A 95th %ILE BUCK TO ALSO BE POSITIVE FOR TYPE.
