From the beginning we bred the Red Line pretty much solely for milk and components. As of January 2018, this family had 3 out of the top five spots on the USDA's Top Doe list, which you can find on adga.org under "Elite Doe."

In this catalogue we said: "This was the best group for a straight dairyman to choose from. They all wear red collars. And the best group for a show herd to avoid. One day we suddenly noticed all the **Old Red Line** ugly milkers had been bought. BUMMER!

Most of the scorecard and the appraisers' "ideal ranges" are about LONGEVITY. But the truth is the average Holstein is only on line for 33 months. You only have room in your life and your barn for "X" number of goats. To earn a living you must immediately replace the low milkers with boomers.

The 2,000 lb DOE WHO LASTS FOR EIGHT YEARS **LOST MONEY FOR YOU EIGHT YEARS IN A ROW.**

The foundation does of the Old Red Line were:

1. REBEL VALLEY'S SOUTHERN BONUS 305 6850. At one time BONUS was recognized as the All-Time All-Breed Record Holder.
2. GOLD BANNER BETSIE LEE OVER 5,000 IN 305. BETSIE LEE also classified at 90!
3. MARIWILLO PRIDE'S SHARMIN, #1 on the Top Ten three different years!

These three led us to MACY –next page a lot of milk but also phenotypic conformation – two GCH legs and a 91.

MACY, aka VERONICA, is a home brew that goes back, way back,

The **New Red Line** comes from ILEX – more milk/fat/protein than MACY or anyone else, but not attachments. Lucky to have an 89. We reserved her before she was born because CARRA her dam was a 99th %ile doe and her planned sire was a Sire Summery aka Elite Buck List buck.

A useful coincidence - MACY and SGCH ALEX, 112A had something in common. Their mammaries can bag up like crazy. Most CAPRIKORN does are going to start dripping at 13 to 16 hours. Maybe even 9 hours. These two could bag for close to 24 hours and hold 17 to 18 lb of milk at any one time. Not recommended. But you can understand that the doe that starts dripping with 7 lb can physically never have a 7,000 lb lactation, and that's where we want to get someday.

She was so scared and wild she wouldn't stand still for the inflations. On Sale Barn day she suddenly started to behave! MACY'S son YOLAND sire of 2011 Sable Jr. Champion of Nat'l Show. Complete show record listed in Saanen show goats catalogue. The great thing about MACY was her abnormal capacity. Her mammary looks big, but not sloppy gigantic. BUYER'S TIP: Often the gawky loose yearlings really come together as 2-year-olds, whereas the very correct more compact yearlings turn into fat butterballs.

Because we know these bloodlines and this is not a mega milk doe. In the second place, she was peaking, and most of the herd was on their way down.

LOVELY MARIA was huge compared to the other yearlings when she first freshened. Her sire KENAY towered over the yearling bucks. When ZEPPO got out of his airplane crate, he was bigger than all our bucks of the same age. Maybe 10 to 20 of them.

ILEX was a 99th percentile doe and her dam CARRA was a 99th percentile doe. At that time there were only 16 living Saanen 99th percentile does. 99 is as high as USDA goes. ILEX beat the whole herd in milk/fat/protein. 3.2% is as high as Saanen's go in protein. An upstanding doe with no attachments.

She is a tribute to Cecile Beauchemin, who had the will power to stay on DHI test for years, and to always breed to Sire Summary/Top buck List/ Elite/ Top 15% bucks. Never bothered to show.

We said: "She is dying as of April 2016."

After being dry for most of 2016, SHE KIDDED FEBRUARY 2017 AT TEN YEARS OLD!

ILEX HAD A VERY HIGH REL - 77! What does that mean? It means she has had 18 kids, 11 does, 6 of the does have been on DHI test. It means that when you look at her Rank of 97, you can count on that. You would rather have a rank of 97 - better than 32 out of 33 Saanens - than a rank of 99 with a 42 REL. Because that 99 may change BIG TIME. But the 97 won't budge much.

Meaning - it looks GOOD but her family as a whole has average udders. Scott hand milked this doe and he really likes her buck kids for a dairyman that does not register. The udder milks down to almost nothing, she is strong, she is friendly, she is big and willing.

She has two very showy daughters: GCH DILEXINA and a second powerhouse; EXOTIC who beat about 20 milkers to get GCH WHILE SHE WAS A YEARLING MILKER Tragedy struck when a buyer chose EXOTIC for \$1,795. Heavy price to pay for a grade. We thought we priced her high enough so that she was safe here. BILEX is so big you have to guess she is a ZEPPO daughter.
